ASEAN EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING PROGRAMME 2017 (AELP 2017) is an inaugural programme by the AUN – STUDENT AFFAIRS NETWORK (AUN-SAN). Universiti Utara Malaysia is indeed honoured to be the first host and the said event will take place from 22 - 26 July, 2017 at Universiti Utara Malaysia in Alor Setar, Malaysia, with the theme "Humanitarian Assistance & Disaster Relief".

In accordance with AUN cost sharing basis, each participant will be responsible for airfares, personal travel insurance and a registration fee of USD100 will be charged, and payment can be made via online (UUM e-Comm, Telegraph Transfer (TT)) 3 weeks prior to the programme. Registration can be made online at http://hep.uum.edu.my/uum-aelp/ and the closing date is on the 1st of July 2017. The fee will only cover local hospitality including meals, airport transfers and accommodation for the students only.

However, your institution may nominate faculty member to accompany the selected students and all expenses pertaining to airfares, accommodation, and personal travel insurance are to be borne by the participating institutions.






