Introduction of the Classes

Korean Language

This course will provide the students with the knowledge of Korean language with the themes such as Korean phonics and alphabet, self-introduction, greeting, asking questions, and ordering & purchasing an item. The topics which will be taught during the second week include asking time, simple conversations with people on street, shopping and how to get to tourist destinations.

Health Assessment Practicum & Medical Terminology

This course will provide the students with the knowledge and skills of health assessment across the life span. It will include health history and physical examination of an individual's body systems in a variety of settings across the life span. Medical Terminology deals with working knowledge and word building skills of the language of health professions. It also covers medical and nursing terms relating to human body structure and function, pathology, diagnosis, and clinical intervention.
