

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CLOONEY FOUNDATION FOR JUSTICE AND CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY REGARDING RENEWAL OF COLLABORATION WITH THE TRIALWATCH PROJECT

This Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into between the Chiang Mai University, Faculty of Law ("CMU"), and the Clooney Foundation for Justice, a not-for-profit organization registered in California ("CFJ" and together with CMU, the "Parties" and each a "Party") as of the 31 st day of May 2022.

WHEREAS, CMU and CFJ wish to continue to collaborate in the implementation of CFJ's TrialWatch® project ("TrialWatch") by monitoring certain *lèse majesté* trials where CFJ and the CMU Fair Trials legal clinical project (the "Fair Trials Clinic" or the "Clinic") believe there to be a high risk of human rights violations.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the Parties agree to continue to participate in the TrialWatch project as follows:

- 1. <u>Duration</u>. The Parties agree to renew their collaboration for a further year from the date of execution of this Agreement. In January 2023, the Parties will assess whether and, if so, how to extend the collaboration further.
- 2. <u>Project Terms.</u> The Parties agree to renew their collaboration pursuant to the same terms and conditions as described in their prior agreement effected May 5, 2020, for the 2021-2022 academic year, and the extension to that agreement, effected May 14, 2021, *mutatis mutandis*, with the following exceptions:
 - (a) Costs: CFJ will provide CMU with USD 10,000, for a total of USD 10,000 over the duration of the project as the remaining funding of the extension of the Agreement effected May 14, 2021. The first tranche of funding (USD 5,000) will be provided on June 1, 2022 (and following execution of this Agreement) and the second tranche (USD 5,000) will be provided on December 1, 2022. CFJ will further pay for bank transfer fees up to USD 150 and an inward remittance fee of 500 baht (to be paid in USD) in connection with each transfer, and will reimburse reasonable case-related expenses

associated with trial monitoring that have been approved in advance in writing by CFJ, including but not limited to, interpretation costs and out-of-town travel expenses.

(b) Methodology: During the period of this Agreement, the Parties will focus on monitoring *lèse majesté* trials in the northern region of Thailand. The Parties will discuss and agree on the appropriate products, including individual case reports in line with the methodology outlined in the prior agreements between the Parties and/or a 'trend report' compiling observations from multiple trials. The Parties will also discuss and agree on appropriate means of launching reports produced under this Agreement in order to maximize impact.
