It is our pleasure to invite your students to participate in **ASEAN in Today's World (AsTW) 2013**. AsTW 2013 is a joint program of Kyushu University (Japan) and Ateneo de Manila University (Philippines) in cooperation with Mahidol University (Thailand) and Fukuoka Women's University (Japan).

Now on its 5th year, AsTW 2013 will be hosted by the Ateneo de Manila University from **February 21 - March 10, 2013**. AsTW is a 2-week international program that will gather undergraduate and graduate students from Asia and provide them an opportunity to attend classes in ASEAN studies and Asian languages/cultures. It will also give them a chance to discover the Philippines through field trips. At the end of the program, credit and grades will be awarded by Kyushu University and an official transcript will be sent to the participants.

Students will stay at My Place Residence Hall, an off-campus accommodation site located in front of the University.

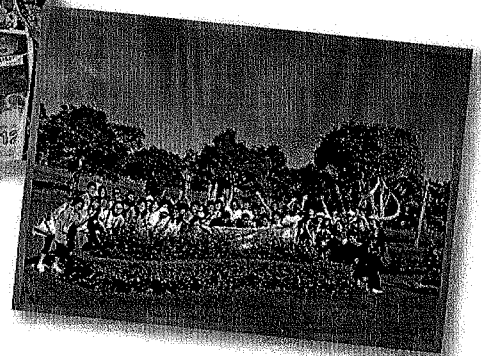

Students from ASEAN countries who have a strong academic record may apply for scholarships.

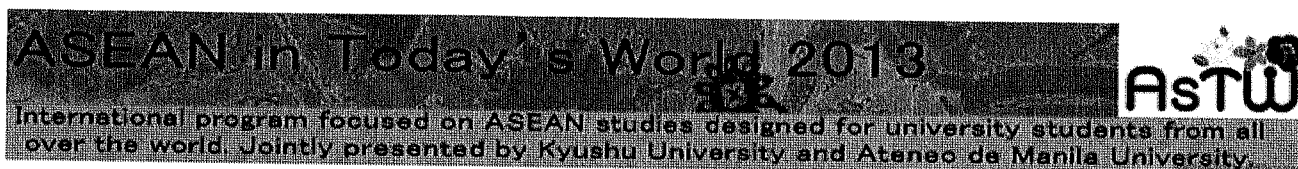

Asian Languages & Cultures (ALC)

The aim of ALC is to help students develop their proficiency in the languages and acquire the basic knowledge of the cultures in an integrated approach. Students will gain a general understanding of the culture and sociolinguistic context of each language. By the end of each course, students are expected to acquire some fundamental skills in listening, speaking, and understanding of daily conduct in the appropriate cultural setting.

1. Basic Japanese Language & Culture
2. Practical Japanese Language and Culture
3. Basic Filipino Language & Culture
4. Basic Thai Language & Culture
5. Bahasa Indonesia & culture
6. Basic Chinese language & culture

(ALC courses are merely provisional and are subject to change.)

<Lecturers & Course Descriptions>

Each course is for 2 credit hours (Kyushu University).
Students will **select one course** from the above four elective ALCs.

Asean Studies Courses (ASC)

Through ASC, students will broaden their knowledge and gain deeper understanding about ASEAN and ASEAN+3 cooperation. Each course is jointly taught by professors from Kyushu University, Ateneo de Manila University, Mahidol University, and Fukuoka Women's University. A speaker from ASEAN Secretariat will be invited to a plenary special lecture for the first-day class. The three separate ASCs will start from the second class. It should be a valuable part of the program that the students will be able to approach ASEAN and Asia from various directions.

Plenary Special Lecture by ASEAN Secretariat

1. Current Affairs of ASEAN and East Asia
2. ASEAN Economics
3. Cross-cultural Communication

<Lecturers & Course Descriptions>

Each course is for 2 credit hours (Kyushu University).
Students will **select one course** from the above three elective ASCs.

Requirement for completion

Students will be required to take two courses (1 ALC + 1 ASC) to complete the program.

The official documents will be sent to each student by regular mail in April or May 2012. Participants should consult their home universities about transferring credit and grades in advance.

Field Trips

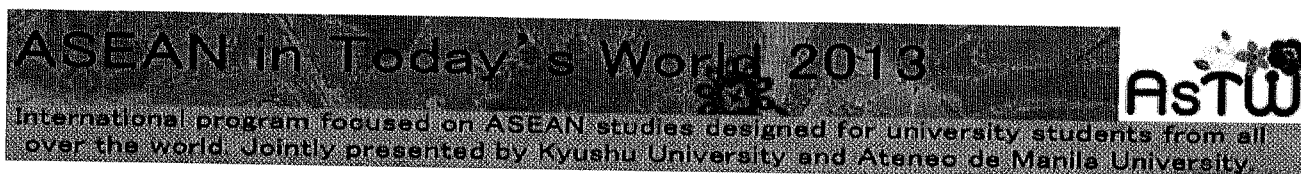

Fees and Costs

These fees and costs are subject to change.

Fees: 133,000 JPY

Fees include tuition, field trips and accommodation fees, but exclude the cost of transportation to Manila.
Payment should be made in Japanese Yen and payment method will be informed to participating students in January 2012.

A scholarship will be awarded by **Kyushu University** up to 15 students from ASEAN countries who have a strong academic record. The ASEAN countries include **Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Vietnam, and Thailand.**

A scholarship is 140,000 yen per person, which covers tuition, accommodation, and study trip fees.

The scholarship award process will be on a competitive basis with an emphasis on applicants that can contribute the most to multi-cultural dynamics in and outside of the classroom. Officials from both Kyushu University and Ateneo de Manila University will make the decision on scholarship recipients.
