It is our pleasure to invite your students to participate in ASEAN in Today's World (AsTw) 2013. AsTW 2013 is a joint program of Kyushu University (Japan) and Ateneo de Manila University (Philippines) in cooperation with Mahidol University (Thailand) and Fukuoka Women's University (Japan).

Now on its 5th year, AsTW 2013 will be hosted by the Ateneo de Manila University from February 21 - March 10, 2013. AsTW is a 2-week international program that will gather undergraduate and graduate students from Asia and provide them an opportunity to attend classes in ASEAN studies and Asian languages/cultures. It will also give them a chance to discover the Philippines through field trips. At the end of the program, credit and grades will be awarded by Kyushu University and an official transcript will be sent to the participants.

Students will stay at My Place Residence Hall, an off-campus accommodation site located in front of the University.

#### Asian Languages & Cultures (ALC)

The aim of ALC is to help students develop their proficiency in the languages and acquire the basic knowledge of the cultures in an integrated approach. Students will gain a general understanding of the culture and sociolinguistic context of each language. By the end of each course, students are expected to acquire some fundamental skills in listening, speaking, and understanding of daily conduct in the appropriate cultural setting.

- Basic Japanese Language & Culture
- Practical Japanese Language and Culture
- Basic Filipino Language & Culture Basic Thai Language & Culture
- Bahasa Indonesia & culture Basic Chinese language & culture

<Lecturers & Course Descriptions>

Each course is for 2 credit hours (Kyushu University). Students will select one course from the above four elective ALCs.

( ALC courses are merely provisional and are subject to change.)

#### Asean Studies Courses (ASC)

Through ASC, students will broaden their knowledge and gain deeper understanding about ASEAN and ASEAN+3 cooperation. Each course is jointly taught by professors from Kyushu University, Ateneo de Manila University, Mahidol University, and Fukuoka Women's University. A speaker from ASEAN Secretariat will be invited to a plenary special lecutre for the first-day class. The three separate ASCs will start from the second class. It should be a valuable part of the program that the students will be able to approach ASEAN and Asia from various directions.

#### **Credit Transfer**

Kyushu University will issue an official document for credit of courses that participanting students completed on AsTW. The official documents will be sent to each student by regular mail in April or May 2012. Participants should consult their home universities about transferring credit and grades in advance.

#### Field Trips

Many field trips will be held during the program. Each excursion is planned in the expectation that students are able to experience some part of Filipino culture. The destinations of AsTW field trips vary and may include Villa Escudero, Tagaytay, Subic (Zambales). Field trip fees are included in the program fees.

A scholarship will be awarded by Kyushu University up to 15 students from ASEAN countries who have a strong academic record. The ASEAN countries include Brunel, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Vietnam, and Thailand.

A scholarship is 140,000 yen per person, which covers tution, accommodation, and stuy trip fees.

The scholarship award process will be on a competitive basis with an emphasis on applicants that can contribute the most to multi-cultural dynamics in and outside of the classroom. Officials from both Kyushu University and Ateneo de Manila University will make the decision on scholarship recipients.
