สรุปเรื่อง

ด้วย National University of Singapore (NUS) ประเทศสิงคโปร์ ได้ส่งอีเมลล์แจ้งมหาวิทยาลัยเชียงใหม่ เพื่อพิจารณาเสนอชื่อนักศึกษา จำนวน ๒ คน สมัครเข้าร่วมโครงการ TEMASEK Foundation Leadership Enrichment and Regional Networking Program โดยนักศึกษาที่เข้าร่วมโครงการต้องเป็นนักศึกษาในระดับปริญญาตรีชั้นปีที่ ๒ ขึ้นไป มีผลการเรียนดี สามารถสื่อสารด้วยภาษาอังกฤษในระดับที่ดีมาก มีความสนใจในการทำงานภาคสังคม ระยะเวลาในการเข้าร่วมโครงการ ๑ ภาคการศึกษา นักศึกษาที่ได้รับคัดเลือกให้เข้าร่วมโครงการจะได้รับทุนจำนวน ๖,๕๐๐ ดอลลาร์สิงคโปร์ ทั้งนี้มหาวิทยาลัยจะต้องเสนอชื่อนักศึกษาเข้าร่วมโครงการฯ ภายในวันที่ ๑๒ สิงหาคม ๒๕๕๖ โดยนักศึกษาที่ได้รับการเสนอชื่อโดยมหาวิทยาลัย จะต้องจัดส่งใบสมัครและเอกสารที่เกี่ยวข้องให้กับ NUS ภายในวันที่ ๑๓ กันยายน ๒๕๕๖ รายละเอียดดังแนบ

INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TEMASEK FOUNDATION LEADERSHIP ENRICHMENT AND REGIONAL NETWORKING PROGRAMME @ NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF SINGAPORE **AY 13/14 SEMESTER 2 (JANUARY-MAY 2014)**

You are warmly invited to nominate two (2) eligible students for the **Temasek Foundation Leadership Enrichment and Regional Networking Programme (LEaRN) @ National University of Singapore by 12 August 2013**. Please use the attached nomination sheet. (More details about the TF LEaRN Programme at the end of the email). Each successful applicant receives an award of S\$ 6,500.

After nominating your students, please forward the information below to your nominated students and the application form which will be sent to you by mid-August 2013. Your help in guiding the students through the nomination process would be appreciated.

1. Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must be:

- Nominated by their home universities;
- Undergraduates who completed at least one year of study in their home universities;
- Studying in their country of citizenship;
- Within the top 10% of their cohort in academic performance;
- Fluent in English;
- Interested in community service as evidenced from participation in activities and projects in their home countries, and preferably have served in leadership positions.

2. Award Requirements

a) Academic Performance

Successful applicants will take a minimum of three and a maximum of four modules during their exchange semester at NUS. They must receive a minimum overall Cumulative Average Point (CAP) of 3.0 out of 5.0.

Please take note of the module restriction

Due to module restrictions, students who require modules, especially from Economics, Business and Law need to be very flexible in their study plan and be prepared to take courses offered by other Faculties and Schools.

More information is at 5b below.

b) Community Involvement

Inbound students are required to spend a minimum of 15 hours on at least 1 community involvement project.

c) Host Family Programme

Inbound students will be matched to a host, who is an NUS returnee. They are strongly encouraged to meet their hosts to network, build relationships and familiarise themselves with local life in Singapore. Do note that there is no home-stay

involved.

d) Participation in all TF LEaRN activities

Examples of activities conducted are the Introductory Briefing, Temasek Learning Journey, Service Learning Workshop and ASEAN event.

e) Submission of documents a month before the end of the semester

- a. Photo-essay of their learning experience
- b. Community log sheet
- c. Online survey

3. Application Procedures

Please note that only applications from students nominated by your office will be processed. Late application and/or incomplete application documents will not be considered.

Nominated students are required to apply for both

- a) TF LEaRN Programme @ NUS and
- b) NUS Student Exchange Programme (Hardcopy and online application) concurrently.

Students must be successful in their Non-Graduating Exchange application (Section 3 and 4 in tables below) in order to participate in the TF LEaRN Programme @ NUS

- § Letter from the home university certifying your level of proficiency in the foreign language if you wish to read language modules in NUS (With prefix "LA". E.g. LAC/LAF)
- § Copy of TOEFL/IELTS - for applicants who wish to read law modules and are from non-English medium universities

4. Outcome of TF LEARN Programme @ NUS result

Successful applicants will be notified of their admission to TF LEARN Programme @ NUS via email by beginning by Mid-October 2013.

5. Other important matters

a. Accommodation

Successful applicants of the TF LEARN Programme @ NUS will have to select "On-campus accommodation" and opt for "Cinnamon College" during the online application - Non-graduating Students Application System (Section 3 in table above). Students who are accepted by the university will receive the offer letter and instructions on how to apply for housing online via email from the Registrar's Office.

b. Module Selection and Restrictions

Successful applicants need to take 3 examinable modules in NUS.

Due to module restrictions, students who require modules, especially from Economics, Business and Law need to be very flexible in their study plan and be prepared to take courses offered by other Faculties and Schools.

Business

- Students must be majoring in business at their home university in order to be considered eligible for Business modules.
- If no Business modules have been secured as mentioned in the Letter of Offer, students will not be able to add any Business module during the Add/Drop period.
- Students applying to study at NUS for 2 semesters will be considered for Business modules in **one semester** only.

Law

- Students must be majoring in Law at their home university in order to be considered eligible for Law modules.
 - Only selective elective Law modules (ie with module code LL4XXX) are available for exchange students.
 - Pure Law major students can expect to take 3-5 Law modules per semester. But students should only take sufficient credits, **not in excess**, as per required by their home university
 - Students with double majors (including Law as one of the majors) must be eligible for a minimum of 2 law modules per semester in order to be considered by the NUS Faculty of Law.
 - Selected students will be informed via email from NUS Faculty of Law to register for the Law modules separately. Note that this is different from module selection done at the stage of application for exchange.
- Failure to register for the Law modules during the stipulated Law registration date will result in no allocated Law modules for the students.**

c. Estimated monthly cost of living in Singapore

Item	Estimated Costs (per month)
Halls/Residence (within campus)	S\$ 550
Food (3 meals a day)	S\$300
Public Transport	S\$100 - S\$150
Books & Stationery (depending on courses)	S\$200 - S\$300
Miscellaneous	S\$200
Total	S\$1,350 - S\$1,500 per month

Since the disbursement of the scholarship will be made January/February 2014, each scholar needs to bring at least S\$ 1250 for their daily expenses during the first month.
