Scholarship for Short-Term Study in Japan

(as of February 2015)

This scholarship is available for qualified international students accepted by Japanese universities on a short-term basis under the student exchange agreement. JASSO selects exchange programs carried out by Japanese universities every year and allocates a scholarship quota to each university. Tohoku University will be able to nominate qualified students for JASSO within that quota.

1. Qualifications

- (1) Students who are officially nominated by Tohoku University's partner universities.
- (2) Students demonstrating excellent academic and personal records at their home university.
- (3) Students having a definite motivation and clear study plan in any field available at Tohoku University and are likely to benefit from studying in Japan.
- (4) Students not having the financial means to study in Japan.
- (5) Students who, upon termination of the period of study in Japan, will resume or complete their studies at their home university.
- (6) Students who will not receive any kind of scholarship more than JPY80,000 per month.
- (7) Students who have not been awarded the JASSO scholarship before.
- (8) Students who are not of Japanese nationality currently.
- (9) Students who have a minimum GPA of 2.30/3.00, which is calculated using JASSO's GPA calculation method, based on a transcript from the previous academic year (see below).

Calculating GPA

- The applicant must demonstrate excellent academic achievements at his/her home university, as well as a good character; in addition, the applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.30/3.00, which is calculated using JASSO's GPA calculation method, based on a transcript from the previous academic year. If the applicant's transcript of the previous academic year is not available, GPA will be calculated based on his/her transcript of the previous semester. In case converting grades using JASSO's calculation method is impossible, we will measure the applicant's academic excellence from their transcript and other materials.
- Meeting JASSO's criteria alone does not guarantee the acceptance to the scholarship program: all applicants go through an on-campus screening process.

They must submit the following forms together with the TSSP/TUJP 2015 application materials through the representative international office at their home institution. Direct applications from students to Tohoku University or to JASSO will not be accepted.

3. Scholarship Conditions

JASSO will provide the following financial assistance through Tohoku University:

- Scholarship (JPY80,000 per month)
- *Students participating in both TSSP and TUJP can receive the JPY80,000 scholarship for both programs (total of JPY160,000).
- *Students enrolling in TUJP for two terms will participate for more than one month, and therefore receive two months' worth of scholarship money (total of JPY160,000).

Note

As the screening process is becoming more rigorous each year, recommendation through Tohoku University for JASSO does not guarantee that candidates will be granted the scholarship.

TSSP 2015

This summer, we will host the **Tohoku University Science Summer Program (TSSP)**, which is designed for undergraduates majoring in science and engineering. The program offers cutting edge classes in advanced sciences and engineering. Our aims are to provide students with insight on what world society needs based on advanced science and technology in the future and how they can contribute to society through research. The participants will have an opportunity to participate in 8 lectures with facility/laboratory visits. At the end of the program students will make a presentation according to the topics given by each lecturer. The following subjects will be covered in our series of lectures with facility/laboratory visits.

- · The 2011 Tohoku Earthquake -Geological Environment and Earthquakes-
- · Spintronics · Computer Vision in Robotics · Robotics · Neutrinos
- · Carbon Nanotube · Modern Physical Chemistry and more

Along with the opportunity to explore advanced science and engineering through the lecture series, we offer Japanese language lectures, field trips to cultural and historical sites and areas struck by the 2011 Tohoku earthquake, Japanese culture workshops and many opportunities to collaborate and interact with Tohoku University students.



Credits

Participating students are required to take 10 lectures (20 hours), attend facility/laboratory visits and participate in group work sessions, after which they will give presentations with their groups. On completing these requirements, students should be eligible for 4 ECTS*.

These credits are not conferred at Tohoku University. Students who require credits for this program should inquire at their home universities.

*1 ECTS credit is equivalent to 25 hours of work.

*ECTS credits are a value allocated to course units to describe the student workload required to complete them.

Accommodation

Each participant will be accommodated in a furnished individual bedroom with a unit bathroom at a hotel located in a convenient area. The cost for the entire stay will be JPY54,600-65,000 for 13 nights (JPY4,200-5,000 per night) depending on the number of participants.

Program Fee

JPY20,000 (incl. tuition, field trips, Japanese culture workshops and other activities) Accommodation, travel and everyday expenses should be paid individually. Students are advised to prepare sufficient money for food and personal expenses.

Scholarship

Qualified students may apply for Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) scholarship of 80,000 yen. Please refer to the JASSO Scholarship Information sheet for the qualifications and procedure.

What's TUJP2015?

This summer intensive program provides students of our partner institutions with an opportunity to "discover" Japan through diverse learning experiences in English. The program offers intensive Japanese language classes for both beginner and intermediate learners, topical seminars in Japanese culture and society, collaborative projects with Japanese students, home-stays and other cultural activities including field trips.



Program schedule

1st term [TUJP-1]: Jul. 6th to Jul.21st, 2015 2nd term [TUJP-2]: Jul. 22nd to Aug. 6th, 2015

Students can choose to take either one term only or both terms according to their preference. Each term contains different classes and activities.

Eligibility

Full-time undergraduate students at partner universities of Tohoku University

Sufficient English ability (Overall TOEFL iBT 70 or PBT 520)

Program fee:

JPY30,000 (ca.USD250) incl. classes, activities, homestay and

field trips

Accommodation:

JPY51,000 (ca.USD425) to 71,400 (ca.USD595) for 1 term/

17 nights (JPY3,000-4,200 per night)

Airfare, accommodation, meals and other everyday expenses are the responsibility of the participant.

Scholarship Opportunity

A Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) scholarship may be awarded to those who meet the requirements below and attend the entire program.

Minimum qualification requirements for JASSO Scholarship

GPA of 2.30 out of 3.00 (JASSO's GPA calculation methods)

Scholarship amount

JPY80,000 per term (JPY160,000 for 2 terms)

Note: USD1 = JPY120 as of February 2015

Credits

On completing the program successfully, students should be eligible to earn 4 ECTS* per term.

*1 ETCS credit is equivalent to 25 hours of work. ECTS credits are a value allocated to course units to describe the student workload required to complete them. Please note that these credits are not conferred at Tohoku University, and each participant needs to negotiate with his/her home institution with the transcripts we issue.

Accommodation

University-contracted off-campus accommodations (hotels) will be a 20-minute walk from Kawauchi campus, where most classes and activities will be held during the program. Each student will be accommodated in a furnished bedroom with a unit bathroom. Breakfast is not included but available upon request (JPY800/meal). Participants will need to pay accommodation fees at the end of the program directly to the hotel.

Insurance

Summer program participants are required to buy travel insurance in their own country BEFORE coming to Japan. Students will be solely responsible for any accidents that occur while staying in Japan. The insurance must cover death and medical care expenses not only due to accidental bodily injury but also for sickness.




