Presentation Challenge

- **Purpose**

To create a platform for young leaders to identify, create and deliver ideas that addresses the needs and opportunities faced by the region, relating to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDG) <http://www.un.org/sustainabledevelopment/sustainable-development-goals/>



Presentation Challenge – Background

- **Overview**

Each team to present a case study and proposed solution(s) related to their home country that addresses the allocated UN SDG

- **Judging Criterion**

Which team proposes the most creative and effective way that addresses the UN SDG in improving livelihoods in a business, economically and socially sustainable way?

- **Innovation** – how unique and interesting was the presentation
- **Impact, Potential, Sustainability** – whether the presentation bears an impact on business, social and economic activities etc.
- **Presentation** – effectiveness and clarity of the presentation

Presentation Challenge – Prizes

- **Format**

- Two teams of the same allocated UN SDG will be challenge each other on center stage
- Each competing team will have an 5-minutes presentation time
- Each presentation round will be allocated 10mins Q&A time from judges and participants

- **Presentation Format**

- Teams are to use the most creative way to articulate the case and proposed solution(s)
- Not restricted to slides and video presentation

- **Pre- Challenge Submission**

- Max. 1 page executive summary of the case study and proposed solution(s)
