The AUAP Secretariat in cooperation with Zhengzhou University, China is pleased to announce the availability of fifty (50) scholarships, for Master Programme (25 candidates) and for the Doctoral Programme (25 candidates).

The criteria of applicants:

The AUAP Secretariat, in cooperation with Zhengzhou University (China), is pleased to announce the 1st AUAP-ZU Scholarships for the Year 2017 and tenable at Zhengzhou University, China. Fifty (50) students from AUAP member institutions will be selected to participate in the coming AUAP- ZU Scholarships for the Year 2017. Members in good standing of AUAP are encouraged to nominate their candidates (faculty members are included).

THE BASIC AUAP'S CRITERIA OF RECRUITMENT ARE LISTED BELOW:

1. Member institution nominating their candidates must be
 - an Active Member (i.e. has paid membership fees for the year 2017 and 2018)
 - or new Active Member (3 years membership payment; 2017-2019)
2. Each member can nominate 1 candidate.
3. Nominating institution must follow the following:
 - 3.1 submit an application (attached), photo and brief introduction of each candidate.

THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES ,TO BE NOMINATED FROM AUAP MEMBER INSTITUTIONS ARE:

1. Holder of a Bachelor or Master degree
2. Grade Point Average must be reasonably high
3. Must pay the air ticket, personal expenses and insurance during their stay.

Remarks: The host (ZU) will cover the accommodation, tuition fee, pick up at the airport.

DEADLINE: Application form with the cover letter from the President/ Rector and Vice Chancellor must be sent to AUAP Secretariat on or **before May 31, 2017 at 12.00 pm., Bangkok, Thailand Time.**

The Secretariat will select the candidates and announce the results on June 15, 2017. Then, the host will issue the formal invitation for candidates to apply for a visa. The Academic Year starts in early September 2017.

Zhengzhou University President Scholarship

I. Category and Duration

II. Scholarship Coverage

Category	Tuition	Accommodation	Stipend
Master student	Full amount of tuition	CNY 10,000/year	No
Doctoral student	Full amount of tuition	CNY 10,000/year	CNY 3,000/month

1. Tuition: The tuition, include the cultivation and management fees, are covered by Scholarship
2. Accommodation: Free on-campus accommodation will be offered. Off-campus accommodation will not be covered by this accommodation subsidy.

III. Program and Medium of Instruction

Please check the attachment, or visit the website <http://international.zzu.edu.cn> for details of each CMI (Chinese as Medium of Instruction) and EMI (English as Medium of Instruction) program.

IV. Eligibility

Applicants should:

1. Be Non-Chinese citizen, healthy, without any crime record, aged<35 for master applicant and aged<45 for doctor applicant;
2. With excellent academic record, potentially to be a highly specialized researcher, engineer or professional;

V. Language Requirement:

1) For candidates applying for CMI doctor program, their minimum HSK should reach Level 6 scored 210. For CMI master program their minimum HSK should reach Level 5 scored 210.

Doctor applicants with minimum HSK Level 4 scored 180 and master with minimum HSK Level 3 scored 180 can apply for the preparatory program before their degree program;

2) For candidates from non-English spoken countries applying for EMI programs, their minimum IELTS

score should reach 6.5;

VI. Application Documents

Applicants submit the following supporting documents:

1. Application form in Chinese or English;
2. The certified copy of highest degree certificate. Documents in language other than Chinese or English should provide a notarized translation version in Chinese or English;
3. The original or notarized copies of transcripts. Documents in language other than Chinese or English should provide a notarized translation version in Chinese or English;;
4. A research plan with minimum 600 words for master program, and a research proposal with minimum 800 words for doctor program in Chinese or English;
5. Two letters of recommendation from associate professors or professors in Chinese or English;
6. Chinese level or English language certificates or equivalent language competence certificates;
7. *Foreigner Physical Examination Form* with original blood test reports in Chinese or English;
8. Certificates of no criminal record. Documents in language other than Chinese or English should provide a notarized translation version in Chinese or English.
