Accommodation

CCU provides:

undergraduate dormitory (on-campus; four students share a room, TWD 7,100 per semester). **graduate dormitory** (on-campus; for master student, two students share a room; for PHD students 1-3 students share a room, TWD 6,800 per semester).

Applicants should book the bed in advance.

Students will be requested to pay TWD 1,600 for security deposit (refundable) and TWD 1,500 for pre-pay electric bill. (Students will get the refund if the electric bill is under that amount. If the electric bill is over than TWD 1,500 then the student have to pay more.)

Dormitory Network Fee: TWD 1,000 per semester.



Dining/Facilities

CCU campus offers a variety of services, including food court, restaurant, coffee shop, photo shops, bookshop, supermarket, 24-hour convenience stores, post office and clinic, which located in the activity center. You could find more restaurants off campus, about 15 minutes walking from the College of Management. Furthermore, there are many restaurants located downtown. The meal price is relatively low, the average cost is around TWD 80.

The facilities in campus included library, computer center, language center, student clubs, sports facilities, such as golf court, tennis court, in-door and outdoor swimming pool and many other full sports facilities. Transportation

Health Insurance/Clinic Cost Students could have the health insurance in their own country but the insurance needed to be cover in Taiwan. If students would like to get the health insurance in Taiwan, the general cost is about NT\$600 per month. When the students are in sickness/illness, they could go to campus clinic for free. Off campus clinic generally cost around TWD 500, depends on the individual medication. Application To complete the application, the exchange applicant must submit following documents by the deadline: (1). Exchange student application form with a recent photograph attached. (2). One copy of passport (at least six months of validity). (3). One official transcript (for all semesters) in English. (4). One recommendation letter in English. (5). Certificate of enrollment (student ID is applicable) in English (6). Softcopy of photo (jpg or gif) We prefer students with 2.8 GPA (2.8/5) or 2.24 GPA (2.24/4) above. **IELTS 6** or **TOEFL ibt 80** or **CEFR B2** above is required. Please prepare proof of overseas health insurance (in English) and proof of Positive Measles and Rubella Antibody or Measles and Rubella Vaccination Certificates (alternative, also in English) after receiving Letter of Acceptance.
