



Most standard university accommodation are 9m² individual rooms which include toilets and showers.

Rooms include a small fridge but students living on the same floor share the kitchen to prepare their meals.

Rents are the more affordable on the housing market: from 230€ per month.

You can also choose to rent rooms or apartments, furnished or not, from private landlords.

The University provides you with its own online accommodation platform to help you find a private room, apartment or flatshare.

The platform's asset? All offers are checked and certified by Studapart so that you can avoid potential troubles!

However, for this type of accommodation, you will need to be autonomous and talk to the landlord directly.

The University can't guarantee the quality of a private accommodation.



Language Resource Centers ('CRL' in French) stand as innovative language learning areas where you can study at your own pace, according to your level, thanks to multimedia devices.

It aims at improving your French language level in a playful and autonomous way.

You can enjoy:

- podcasts
- movies and documentaries in subtitled original versions
- novels, magazines, newspapers in original language versions
- learning softwares
- conversation/chat rooms

You can also obtain 3 ECTS by participating to a conversation program called "Service-Learning". There is also an on-site team of teachers and instructors to guide you with the use of resources, throughout your learning experience.

There are currently 7 CRLs, one per faculty.

Every campus has its own university library.

HEALTH SERVICE

Extimate your Budget EXAMPLE OF MONTHLY EXPENSES IN TOURS



As for a typical monthly budget in Tours, you should anticipate to spend at least 700-800€ on average: it includes rent and cost of transportation, food, outings and leisure activities, as well as upkeep costs.

On the 1st month, this budget is doubled because you will face extra costs related to your settlement: rent deposit, additional equipment for your accommodation, insurances, French immigration office (OFII) tax, etc...


