

2022 CUC Summer Program

1. Period

10 days from Wednesday, August 17 to Friday, August 26, 2022

Decision to hold the Summer Program will depend on the following:

- The period of quarantine upon entry into Japan is less than 3 days.
- Participants can enter Japan with a tourist visa.
- Participants have completed the third round of vaccinations recognized as valid in Japan.
- The decision will be made based on the coronavirus situation at the end of June.
- Even after the decision in June, the Program may be cancelled depending on circumstances.

If the Program is cancelled, the participants themselves must pay the cancellation fee for their airline tickets, etc.

2. Number of Participants

-Maximum of two students from each university.

* One male and one female due to our accommodation. They will share an apartment with another student of the same sex from a different university.

-Students who have already participated in the CUC Summer Program before are not eligible to apply to this program.

3. Provided by CUC

Lectures, Activities, Accommodation, Meals (except on weekends)

4. Accommodation

During the program, participants will stay in the International dormitory on campus.

- Check-out is on Friday, August 26 between 9 am and 12:00

6. Overseas travel insurance

All participants must buy their traveler's insurance which covers the duration of the trip, from the departure date to the date of return to their home country. CUC will ask participants to submit the PDF files of their insurance copy before the start of the program.
