

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made between University of New England (UNE) through its School of Law (UNE School of Law) and Chiang Mai University (CMU) through its Faculty of Law (CMU Faculty of Law) in accordance with the Details and Terms.

Introduction	A. UNE is a public university located at Armidale in regional New South Wales, Australia. UNE School of Law provides legal education and world standard research for people living in Australia and overseas. B. Chiang Mai University, established as a public university under the <i>Chiang Mai University Act 2508 (1965)</i> , is a public and autonomous university established under the <i>Chiang Mai University Act B.E 2551(2008)</i> and located at 239 Huay Kaew Road, Muang District, Chiang Mai, Thailand. C. This MOU demonstrates an intention by UNE School of Law and CMU to negotiate a cooperative arrangement with a view to entering a separate legally-binding Agreement to promote potential research and academic collaboration in the areas listed in clause 1 in a spirit of equality for mutual benefit.

TERMS

1. Scope of co-operation

- 1.1 The Parties intend to promote a climate of open exchange and cooperation to negotiate a cooperative arrangement with a view to entering a separate legally-binding Agreement for each agreed joint activity. More specifically, the Parties will discuss any one or more of the following areas of mutual interest:
- (a) exchange of teaching and research staff of the Parties;
 - (b) exchange of students between the Parties;
 - (c) participation of staff and students of the Parties in short courses, formal and informal seminars and study visits;

- (d) collaboration in research projects between academic staff of the Parties;
 - (e) collaboration for conferences and other academic meetings;
 - (f) joint postgraduate programs between the Parties
 - (f) special projects for mutual benefit.
- 1.2. The conditions for progressing from this MOU to a formal Agreement will be:
- (a) a documented evaluation and review of the relationship during the period of this MOU;
 - (b) demonstrated mutual benefit to the Parties;
 - (c) clear and defined objectives for the proposed formal relationship.

2. Facilitation

- 2.1 The cooperation will be overseen by designated representatives of the Parties.
- 2.2 For UNE School of Law, the designated person is Dr Same Varayudej and for the other Party, the designated person is Ms Kanya Hirunwattanapong.

3. Period of MOU

This MOU is effective for five years from the date of signing or when a separate legally-binding Agreement is signed, or until ended by either Party giving 60 days written notice to the other Party, whichever occurs first.

4. Relationship


Nothing in this MOU creates an agency, partnership, joint venture or employment relationship between the Parties or any of their respective officers, employees, contractors or agents.

5. Specific cooperative activities

Matters of detail relating to specific cooperative activities, projects and other matters relating to the implementation of this MOU will be negotiated and executed under a separate legally-binding Agreement and relevant supporting agreements.

6. Legal Effect of this MOU

This MOU is only to express the intentions of the Parties. The expressed intentions are not binding and no legally-binding obligations are intended to, or do, arise as a consequence of the signing of this MOU. Actions taken by either Party in reliance on this MOU will be at that Party's sole risk.
