

## Framework Cooperation Agreement between

## Guangxi Institute of Economic & Political Studies on Southeast Asia

Faculty of Law, Chiang Mai University

Guangxi Institute of Economic & Political Studies on Southeast Asia, the People's Republic of China, and Faculty of Law, Chiang Mai University, Thailand are interested in bringing a more global dimension to their curricula, seminars and researches.

The agreement, therefore, is made as a gesture of goodwill between the two institutions and offers mutual benefit through cooperative efforts. The scope and procedural details are:

- 1. The two parties agree to encourage and promote the following academic and scholarly activities:
  - a) Exchange of academic researchers
  - b) Exchange of academic materials and other information
  - c) Joint research activities and publications
  - d) Joint performance and exhibition activities
  - e) Participation in seminars/workshops and academic meetings
  - f) Participation in special short-term academic and cultural programs
- 2. This agreement shall be valid for five years from the date of signing. Revision or renewal of this cooperative link is subject to mutual consent from both parties.
- 3. It is expected that this agreement will lead to more specific collaborative agreements between the two parties. Details of the implementation of any particular activities resulting from this agreement shall be negotiated between the two parties as such specific cases arise.
- 4. Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the party initiating the notice. Such notification must be received by the other party at least a month prior to the effective date of termination. In the case of termination, it will not affect the completion of any activities underway or any previously advertised activities at the time that notice of termination is given.

This agreement serves as the parties' intentions to work together to promote academic and educational linkage and does not constitute a legally binding agreement between the parties involved.
