

**Memorandum of Understanding
between**

Faculty of Law- Universitas Pelita Harapan, Indonesia

And

Faculty of Law- Chiang Mai University, Thailand

In order to extend the effective and mutually beneficial cooperation and develop academic and cultural exchange in education, research and other areas, both parties hereby agree to cooperate toward the internationalization of higher education in the ASEAN region.

The areas of cooperation will include any program offered at either party which is felt to promote the above-mentioned goals. However, any specific program shall be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds and the approval of both parties. Such program may include:

- a) joint academic & scientific activities, courses, conferences, seminars, symposia or lecturers, collaborative research, and joint publication of law journals.
- b) exchange of students, faculty members and research scholars.
- c) exchange of materials in education & research, publications and academic information.

The terms of such mutual assistance and cooperation shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the responsible authority of each party prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.

The agreement shall be effective for an initial period of 5 (five) years from the date it is signed by both parties. It will be automatically extended for a new five year term, unless either party expresses their objection in writing. This agreement may be terminated by either party by providing a written notice to the other at least six months prior to the beginning of an academic year. The program will be subject to an internal evaluation every 2 (two) years.
