



**STRATEGIC PARTNER AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
GUANGXI SIBEI LAW FIRM
AND
FACULTY OF LAW, CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY**

This agreement for the mutual support and collaboration is entered into between Guangxi Sabei Law Firm and Faculty of Law, Chiang Mai University (hereinafter FoL). To carry out the purpose of this agreement, Guangxi Sabei Law Firm and FoL agree to the following provisions:

Article I - Purpose of the Agreement

The purpose of the present Agreement is to establish a formal relationship between both partners in the shared opinion that such collaboration based on mutual support shall help facilitate the exchange of legal knowledge both practical and theoretical beneficial to both partners.

Article II – Collaboration

The present Agreement aims to further the launch of collaborative efforts in four areas:

- **Student exchanges.** Every year 2-4 excellent students will be selected by FoL to complete their internships in Guangxi Sabei Law Firm for the duration of two - four months. Guangxi Sabei Law Firm shall act as the host and provide the return air tickets and accommodation expenses for the interns, while the cost of living expenses shall be borne by the interns.
- **Intellectual supports.** The Thai-China Legal Service Center at FoL will provide intellectual supports to Guangxi Sabei Law Firm or Sabei (Thailand) Law Firm in its law-related endeavors.
- **Knowledge and cultural exchanges.** Both partners agree to conduct legal and cultural knowledge exchange activities.
- **Graduates recommendation.** The FoL may recommend promising graduates to submit their job applications to Sabei (Thailand) Law Firm.

Additional considerations pertaining to specific rights and obligations shall be negotiated separately by both partners.

Article III – Funding

The financial agreements pertaining to the execution of projects will be established through consultations between the two partners in accordance with each collaboration projects.

Article IV – Modifications of the Agreement

The present Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement at the request of one of the partners. Said amendments shall come into effect as of the date set by both institutions.

Article IV – Modifications of the Agreement

The present Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement at the request of one of the partners. Said amendments shall come into effect as of the date set by both institutions.



Article V – Duration of the Agreement

The present Agreement will come into effect on the date of its signing by the authorities and will remain in force for a period of five years. It will automatically be renewed at regular intervals for the same period, however each party may move, in writing and with six months' notice to this effect, to amend or terminate the Agreement.

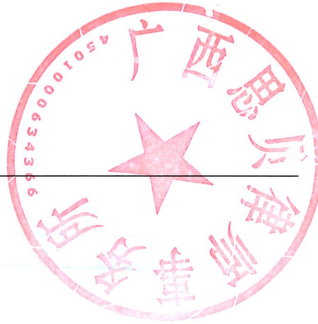
