

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



between

FACULTY OF LAW, CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY, THAILAND

and

SCHOOL OF LAW AND JUSTICE, SOUTHERN CROSS UNIVERSITY, AUSTRALIA

The Dean of the Faculty of Law, Chiang Mai University, Thailand and the Dean of the School of Law and Justice, Southern Cross University, Australia, hereby agree to encourage and promote academic cooperation and exchange between their two universities. The scope and procedural details of the Memorandum of Understanding are delineated below:

- 1. The two universities agree to encourage and promote the following academic and educational activities:
 - (a) Exchange of faculty and staff members
 - (b) Exchange of students
 - (c) Exchange of publications and relevant academic and educational information
 - (d) Joint research, lectures and symposia
 - (e) Other activities such as deemed appropriate by mutual consent
- 2. Financial arrangements and stipulations concerning, for example, the exchange of students, faculty and staff members, are to be specially detailed in separate addenda.
- 3. Modifications and /or amendments to this Memorandum of Understanding can be executed by mutual consent.
- 4. Should either university wish to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding, written notice should be given six (6) months in advance of the desired termination date.

Both universities agree to review this Memorandum of Understanding after five years following the date of signing. It shall be automatically renewed for successive five-year periods unless either party gives the other written notice of its desire to either terminate or revise this Memorandum twelve months prior to the termination of a given five-year period.
