

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

FACULTY OF LAW, CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY, THAILAND

and

SCHOOL OF LAW, UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS HCMC, VIETNAM

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is made by and between the Faculty of Law, Chiang Mai University, Thailand, and School of Law, University of Economics HCMC, Vietnam.

RECITALS

WHEREAS the Faculty of Law, Chiang Mai University, Thailand, and School of Law, University of Economics HCMC, Vietnam both have law related programs and that have been working in legal research and the legal education of students; and

WHEREAS, the Faculty of Law, Chiang Mai University, Thailand, and School of Law, University of Economics HCMC, Vietnam desire to encourage and promote academic cooperation and exchange between their two faculties,

NOW THEREFORE, in regarding of the mutually beneficial relationships to be manifested, and in consideration of the mutual promises and understanding contained herein, the scope and procedural details of the Memorandum of Understanding are delineated below:

1. Purpose of the MOU

1.1 The primary objective of this MOU is to create an indication of collaborative efforts between Faculty of Law, Chiang Mai University, Thailand and School of Law, University of Economics HCMC, Vietnam to affect the academic interchange of faculty, and students, and academic and research information between the two Faculties.

1.2 The two faculties agree that this MOU will provide the fundament and framework for later specific projects, developed by academic and administrative members from the two Faculties, to be agreed upon in other separate written agreements.

2. Collaboration Activities

The two Faculties agree to encourage and advocate the following academic and educational activities on a basis of equality and reciprocity:

- (a) Exchange of academic and administrative staff,
- (b) Exchange of students,

- (c) Exchange of selected publications and relevant academic information and materials, upon the consent of the responsible staff.
- (d) Conducting collaborative research project in fields of mutual interest, lectures, and organizing symposia,
- (e) Promoting other academic cooperation and activities such as deemed appropriate by mutual consent.
- (f) Join teaching methodologies and research methods
- (g) Conducting joint executive course in areas of mutual interest
- (h) The development of an internship placement agreement or similar at the undergraduate and postgraduate program level.

3. Financial Arrangements

Financial arrangements and stipulations concerning, for example, the exchange of students, faculty, and staff members, are to be specially detailed in separate addenda.

4. Intellectual Property and Research Collaboration Agreements

All publications and outcomes deriving from the educational, research between the two faculties shall acknowledge the presence of the collaboration established under this MOU. In addition, the relationship between the two faculties shall be mentioned in all courses and formal presentations which are the outcome of any collaboration formed under this MOU.

5. Validation Period of this MOU

This MOU is intended to provide a framework for discrete and more detailed written agreements by and between the two faculties regarding exchange attempts. In this context, this MOU shall remain effective until:


- 5.1 Replaced by such a separate formal written agreement(s).
- 5.2 Terminated by either Faculty upon written notice of not less than six (6) months; or
- 5.3 Three (3) years from the date of signing, unless the two Faculties mutually agree in writing to extend this MOU.
- 5.4 Modifications and /or amendments to this MOU can be executed in writing by mutual consent.
- 5.5 Both faculties agree to review this MOU after three years following the date of signing. It shall be automatically renewed for successive three-year periods unless the above-mentioned cases.
