Eligibility Criteria

- Be currently enrolled as an undergraduate student at a partner university
- Demonstrate strong academic performance and active participation
- Have a good command of English (sufficient for academic participation)
- Show interest in maritime, ocean-related fields, or global challenges
- Open-minded attitude and willingness to engage in multicultural environments
- Be in good physical and mental health to participate in all program activities

Important Notes

- Applicants must be officially nominated by their home university
- Final selection will be made by KMOU based on overall qualifications
- Participation is subject to visa approval and program requirements
